Acne Preparations
Allergy medications
Cough and Cold Preparations
Sedatives or Hypnotics

Analgesics (*Aspirin 325 & Ibuprofen are covered*)
Psychotropics
Tuberculosis medications
HIV medications

* This is not an ALL Exclusive or Inclusive list of medications All medications must be for treatment related to end stage renal disease. Medications are for the treatment of renal disease, not the cause of the renal disease. Please note that the program will only pay for a maximum of a 30 day supply 1x/month. If an early refill is required for a change in dosage, this must be noted on the invoice sent to the program. The program reserves the right to refuse payment for any item it deems unrelated to the treatment of End Stage Renal Disease.
